ABOUT RESPONSIBLE SHALE DEVELOPMENT

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1 \$1+ Billion

Has been invested by Pa.'s shale industry in road and infrastructure improvements since 2008 (*MSC study*)



2  Shale production increased U.S. household incomes by an average of \$1,200 in 2012 (*IHS Global*)

3 \$2.1 Billion
In tax revenue has been generated in Pa. by responsible shale development (*Pa. Dept. of Revenue*)

4 **BRIDGES**
\$3.4 million in impact fees have been directed toward bridge repairs in Montgomery Co., Pa. alone (*Philadelphia Inquirer*)


5 96%
Of new industry hires were from the Appalachian Basin in 2012 (*MSC study*)

6 The U.S. has surpassed Russia as the world's largest oil and natural gas producer (*USA Today*)



7 \$45 Billion
In consumer utility costs were saved thanks to shale production over the last three years or \$650 per household (*TD Bank*)

8 In 2013, safe shale development supported 245,000 Pa. jobs, with an average core job paying \$90,000 a year (*Pa. Dept. of L&I*)



9 \$630+ Million
Was distributed overwhelmingly to local communities in natural gas impact fees in 2013 (*Pa. Public Utility Commission*)

10  1.7 million U.S. jobs are attributable to shale development today; expected to rise to 3 million by 2020 (*IHS Inc.*)
