

PA DEP AIR QUALITY GENERAL PERMIT TRAINING

APRIL 12, 2018

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) is finalizing a new Air Quality General Permit (GP-5A) for upstream natural gas production activities and revising the existing Air Quality General Permit (GP-5), required for midstream and pipeline activities, planned for the first quarter of 2018.

Join oil and gas industry stakeholders to obtain a detailed overview of the two Air Quality General Permits. First, PA DEP officials will walkthrough what is required to obtain approval for the new GP-5A and what activities may still qualify for the Category 38 Exemption. Similarly, PA DEP will step through the updated GP-5 permit and define what is required to obtain approval.
