POSITION OVERVIEW

The Marcellus Shale Coalition (MSC) is looking for a candidate who will focus on Strategic Project Management. This position reports directly to the EVP, Technical Affairs and works with MSC staff and member companies to support special projects and MSC committee initiatives around the safe development of natural gas. Serving multiple MSC office and event locations, the Manager will based in the MSC's corporate office. The need for this position is immediate and we anticipate having the Manager begin their work no later than April 2012.

More specifically, the Manager is responsible for:

- Overall project management with active engagement from kick-off through commissioning
- Defining project scope, objectives and deliverables that support business goals in collaboration with senior management and stakeholders
