1 \$750M

Has been invested by Pa.'s shale industry in road and infrastructure improvements since 2008 *(MSC study)*



Shale production increased U.S. household incomes by an average of \$1,200 in 2012 *(IHS Global)*

In tax revenue has been generated in Pa. by responsible shale development *(Pa. Dept. of Revenue)*

4 BRIDGES

\$3.4 million in impact fees were directed toward bridge repairs in Montgomery Co., Pa. alone

Of new industry hires were from the Appalachian Basin in 2012 *(MSC study)*

6 The U.S. is expected surpass Russia and Saudi Arabia as the world's largest oil and natural gas producer in 2013 *(U.S. EIA)*

In consumer utility costs were saved thanks to shale production over the last three years or \$650 per household *(TD Bank)*

8 In 2013, safe shale development supported 232,000 Pa. jobs, with an average core job paying \$83,305 a year *(Pa. Dept. of L&I)*

Was distributed overwhelmingly to local communities in impact fees *(Pa. Public Utility Commission)*



10 1.7 million U.S. jobs are attributable to shale development today; expected to rise to 3 million by 2020 *(IHS Inc.)*
