Part One: Hours-of-Service (HOS)

FMCSA Safety Investigators will hold an Hours-of-Service (HOS) workshop specifically geared toward enhancing participant's knowledge of the current HOS regulations and related natural gas/oilfield exceptions. The presentation will include a review of best practices as well as hands-on learning activities to help reinforce participants understanding of the HOS rules.

Part Two: Compliance, Safety, and Accountability (CSA), and Driver Qualifications

FMCSA Safety Investigators will provide an update on the latest information involving Compliance, Safety, and Accountability (CSA), discuss the requirements pertaining to Driver Qualifications along with a briefing on The National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners. The National Registry is a new program that will require all medical examiners who wish to perform physical examinations for interstate drivers to be trained and certified in FMCSA physical qualification standards.
