

Pipeline Safety Seminar Tuesday, February 25, 2014

The significance of pipeline safety has grown dramatically in recent years, primarily as a result of several high-profile incidents and the development of the nation's shale plays. The U.S. Department of Transportation's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) is the federal agency responsible for ensuring the safety of gas and hazardous liquid pipelines and liquefied natural gas (LNG) facilities. PHMSA also administers a grant program that allows states to regulate certain pipelines and LNG facilities in their jurisdictions.

The seminar will include a series of presentations on current issues in pipeline safety, including an overview of the federal and state regulatory programs, a discussion of the regulations for gas and hazardous liquid gathering lines and the special concerns that arise for legacy pipeline systems, and a review of the various pipeline-safety-related reporting obligations that apply to operators. The seminar will also include a panel discussion consisting of state regulators from West Virginia, Pennsylvania, and Ohio. The purpose of the panel will be to provide insight into the pipeline safety issues confronting the midstream sector in the Marcellus and Utica shale plays.
