The Marcellus Shale Coalition's Threatened and Endangered Species Workgroup in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) are pleased to offer a Pennsylvania Conservation Explorer—Conservation Planning and PNDI Environmental Review Training. This training is being offered to all oil and gas industry stakeholders.

The Pennsylvania Natural Diversity Inventory (PNDI) Environmental Review Tool was built in 2003 and was the first online database and screening tool to protect state and federal sensitive species. In 2014, the DCNR commissioned an upgrade to the tool which includes both Conservation Planning and Environmental Review capabilities within the tool on a GIS platform. At this training, the DCNR will discuss the NEW Conservation Explorer online tool and focus on the ability for the industry to better plan projects, avoid conflicts with sensitive species and promote conservation. In addition to completing a "walk-through" of the tool, DCNR staff will present example projects to familiarize users with the capabilities, data resources, and information which have been added as part of the upgrade.
